

Subject matter of the five ‚exhibition-stars‘:

The exhibition is not directional and the order in which the visitor completes her visit to this area is unimportant.

Star 1

- Bay 1: What do we mean by deep?
- Bay 2: Myths of the deep
- Bay 3: 20.000 Leagues under the sea

This star contains the preferred introduction matter to the subject material, but is certainly not the obligatory start! There are no special exhibits allotted to star 1. In Bay 3 a video clip from the film „20.000 Leagues under the sea“ by Jules Verne is running continuously.

Star 2

- Bay 4: The cradle of life?
- Bay 5: Life without light
- Bay 6: Natures tricks with light

The „Black Smoker“-Cabinet and the ‚liftable flap‘ column stands near Star 2.

Star 3

- Bay 7: Fight of the giants
- Bay 8: Sperm whale
- Bay 9: And they are there!

The Cabinet with the giant squid tentacle is situated near Star 3. In Bay 8 a sperm whale whirl is placed and a scene from the film „Moby Dick“ is running. In Bay 9 the smell of the flesh of a giant squid is given off from an opening. It is recommended that the rear-view of the „Yellow Submarine quiz box“ with the poster-wall should be placed Near Bay 8.

Star 4

- Bay 10: History of deep-sea research
- Bay 11: Bathysphere Trieste
- Bay 12: The world of the monster

The Cabinets „Trieste 1“ and „Trieste 2“ and the Cabinet „Deep-sea monster“ belong to the grouping around Star 4. These, along with the interactive video-column „Jacques Piccard“, the media box and the diving-boat „Bathysphere Trieste“, form a focal point for the exhibition.

Star 5

- Stop deep-sea fishing!
- Gold rush in the Deep-sea
- As if from another world

The „Deep-sea net“ stand is placed near Star 5.

The work table is placed in a suitable child-friendly position in your shopping centre.
